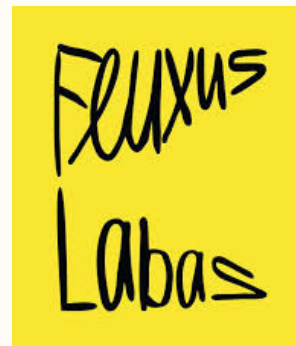


2018

This year, we officially established “Anthropos”! After many months of meetings, discussions, planning, and information gathering, in January we established a legal entity – the Applied Anthropology Association (later renamed as an organization) called “Anthropos.” This was, of course, one of the biggest steps, but only the first. Many more things awaited us that we had to learn and plan. From internal issues and regulations to learning how to write projects, gathering information about ongoing funding calls, and participating in our first presentations and seminars under the name of “Anthropos.”

WHAT DID WE ACHIEVE?

1. We established the organization! Five of us took part in founding it – Kornelija, Ugnė, Indra, Dovilė, and Justinas, and at the end of the year Marija also joined.
2. We created our social media accounts. In February, we organized a public presentation of “Anthropos.”
3. We participated in the “Fluxus Labas” training sessions organized by the “Kaunas 2022” city community program, where, alongside other researchers and anthropologists, “Anthropos” also introduced anthropological methods useful for working with communities. We wrote and submitted our first projects.
4. Although the first attempts were not very successful, we established long-term partnerships. Having learned from the experience, at the end of the year we submitted the anthropology workshop project “Initiatives for Kaunas” and received funding.
5. Indra joined the Kaunas Biennial project “Magic Carpets,” where she will conduct qualitative research with artists over the next five years.



2018 BUDGET:

- The association collected EUR 20 in membership fees.
- It did not engage in commercial activities and received no income.
- Support received through the allocated 2% income tax contribution amounted to EUR 64.99.
- Unused funds remaining at the end of the year amounted to EUR 65.64.
- Expenses for banking services and advertising costs (website) amounted to EUR 19.35.
