

# 2023

The year 2023 was an intensive period of growth and implementation for the organization. Significant attention was devoted to research and educational activities – focus group and survey projects were successfully implemented, enabling deeper analysis of sensitive topics. At the same time, the methodological foundation was strengthened, and new research and training tools were developed.

The year was also marked by international engagement – a significant ERASMUS+ project was implemented, bringing together international partners and participants while strengthening the organization’s competencies in the areas of cultural representation and discrimination.

Active organizational growth also took place: internal processes were strengthened, strategy development was advanced, and new project and funding opportunities were explored.

## **WHAT HAVE WE ACHIEVED?**

- An ERASMUS+ project was planned and implemented – preparations took place through partner meetings, programme coordination, and participant recruitment, while the main activities were carried out on August 6–11.
- Cultural sensitivity training sessions were organized, their programme was prepared and coordinated, and the first training sessions took place at the beginning of the year.
- Workshops on cultural appropriation were organized at the Museum of Stories (April).
- MO Museum focus groups were implemented, their analysis was completed, and the results were presented in June.
- Ongoing administrative activities were carried out (reports, accounting).
- Work was done on internal organizational processes (communication, website, regulations, project development).
- The organization’s strategy was further developed, and new project and funding opportunities were explored.
- Updates to the general education curricula (BUP) and their implementation were monitored and discussed.

## **WE WROTE, SUBMITTED, AND IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS:**

1. Together with partners from the Roma children’s day centre “Padėk Pritapti,” we conducted a qualitative study on the accessibility of public healthcare services for Roma people in Vilnius City Municipality. Client: Vilnius City Municipality Administration. 2022-10 – 2023-02.



2. We accredited the training programme “Strengthening Intercultural Competencies in School Communities.”
3. At the School Improvement Centre, we organized training sessions for school communities; however, it was not possible to gather a sufficient number of participants. We conducted an evaluation study of the MO Museum project “The Exchange of Visual Thinking in Art and the Educational Process.” Client: MO Museum. 2023-04 – 2023-06.
4. We led workshops on cultural appropriation at the House of Histories. Client: House of Histories. 2023-04-22.
5. Together with the Vilnius Museum, we implemented the project “Krasnūcha: Laboratory of Knowledge” for the Lithuanian Council for Culture. The project was funded by the Lithuanian Council for Culture. 2023-06 – 2023-10.
6. We implemented the educational ERASMUS+ project “Towards Ethical Cultural Representations in Advocacy Work.” The project was funded by the ERASMUS+ Youth Worker Mobility Programme. 2023-08-06 – 2023-08-11.
7. For the fifth consecutive year, we implemented the anthropology workshops “Anthropology Workshops 2023: Migration, Borders, and Catastrophes.” The project was funded by the Kaunas Initiatives Programme and Kaunas City Municipality. 2023-12-02.
8. We conducted a study on an inclusive work environment for LGBT+ employees. Client: AB Ignitis Group. 2023-09 – 2024-02.
9. We prepared an application and held meetings with partners for an ERASMUS+ cooperation partnerships in youth application.
10. Together with partners from Latvia, we submitted a project in which Anthropos participated as a partner. The project aimed to explore accessibility in Lithuanian and Latvian cities for young people experiencing mobility challenges. The application was submitted to the Erasmus cooperation projects programme. The project was approved.
11. As social partners, Anthropos participated in the defence of master’s theses in the Vytautas Magnus University Social Anthropology programme. 2023-05-29.

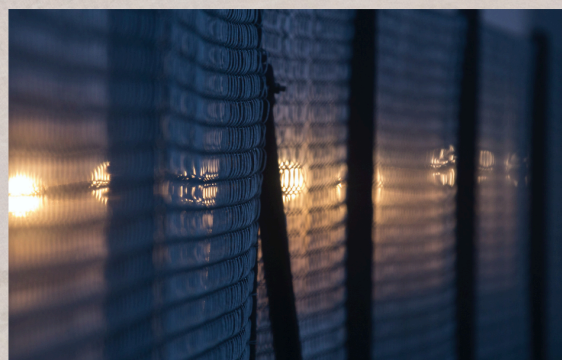
