WHAT HAVE WE ACHIEVED?

1. Together with partners from the Netherlands, Greece, and Portugal, we are implementing the Erasmus+ KA2 project "The Octopus' Project: Ensuring a Space Suitable for Neuro-diverse People." The lead partner is CAAT Projects, Netherlands. 2024–2026.
2. Together with partners from Latvia, Spain, and the Netherlands, we are implementing the Erasmus+ KA2 partnership project "Empowering Through Representation: Toolkit for Good Practices." Our organization is the lead coordinator. 2025–2027.
3. Together with partners from Latvia, we completed the project "Be ribų" ("Without Restrictions"), aimed at exploring accessibility in Lithuanian and Latvian cities for young people experiencing mobility challenges. Funded by Erasmus+. 2024-02-11 – 2025-07-10.
4. We carried out an evaluation of the MO Museum's Millennium Schools programme "Visual Thinking Strategy in Literature Lessons" by conducting teacher surveys. Client: MO Museum. 2024-04 – 2026-09.
